Options for High School Students



Earn College Credits

- Legislation allows high school students to earn college credits
- Tuition free courses
- School districts may pay fees or assist with textbooks
- Early college and dual enrollment programs

Benefits

- Save money
 - \$250/class at Mitchell
 - \$1,500/class at UNC System school
- Save time
 - Earn high school and college credit for the same course
- Gain experience
 - Prepare for university
 - Skills for a career
- Boost high school GPA

Early College

- Grades 9-13
- Apply during 8th grade (limited transfer spaces)
- Competitive application process
- Collaborative College for Technology and Leadership on the Statesville campus of Mitchell
- Crossroads Arts and Science Early College on the campus of Statesville High School
- Agriculture and Science Early College on the campus of North Iredell High School
- May enroll in any degree at Mitchell
- Likely to complete full degree
- No cost to student (early college pays fees & books)

Career & College Promise

- Grades 11-12
- Apply during any eligible semester
- Remain enrolled in original high school
- Transfer and career options
- Application considers GPA and college-readiness test scores
- Earn a credential before high school graduation
- May enroll in structured pathway
- Unlikely to complete full degree, but all credits count toward degree completion
- Student responsible for books (ISS/MGSD pays fees)

Program Eligibility

- Junior or senior
- 2.8 unweighted high school GPA or qualifying test scores in English, reading, and math
- GPA waiver allowed in SOME CTE pathways, based on the individual student

College Transfer Pathways

- For students who plan to earn a 4 year degree
- Classes transfer to any UNC system school and most private colleges and universities in NC



College Transfer Pathway Requirements

- Junior or Senior
- GPA ≥2.8 (unweighted)

OR

Qualifying English, math, & reading scores

NOTE: Students may enroll in only one College Transfer Pathway. *With permission* from the high school principal/designee and the college's CAO, students who qualify for a College Transfer Pathway may also enroll in one Career and Technical Education Pathway. Students may register **ONLY** for courses listed within their pathway(s).

 BEFORE high school
 graduation
- Select up to 2 different pathways
