College Admissions:

- ✓ Stay focused and finish high school strong
- ✓ Continue to submit admission applications before the deadlines
- ✓ Check your colleges' admissions portals and email regularly
- ✓ Rank your top schools as you prepare to make a decision.
- ✓ Sign up for accepted students visitation days at schools ranked high on your list
- ✓ Once you've decided, confirm your decision with the school of your choice, pay the deposit (if necessary), and inform the other schools you've decided not to attend
- Communicate to the Schools you have decided NOT to attend so they can open your spot to another student.

Financial Aid:

- ✓ Confirm deadlines and financial aid forms required at each school; many schools have a March 1 priority deadline
- ✓ Complete and submit the FAFSA and CSS/PROFILE, if required
- ✓ Review your FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR); if your FAFSA was selected for verification, request a tax transcript from the IRS for your 2018 taxes and submit it along with any other required documents according to your schools' instructions
- ✓ Compare financial aid offers to help make your decision
- Review your high school's scholarship bulletin, online scholarship resources, and apply for scholarships
