

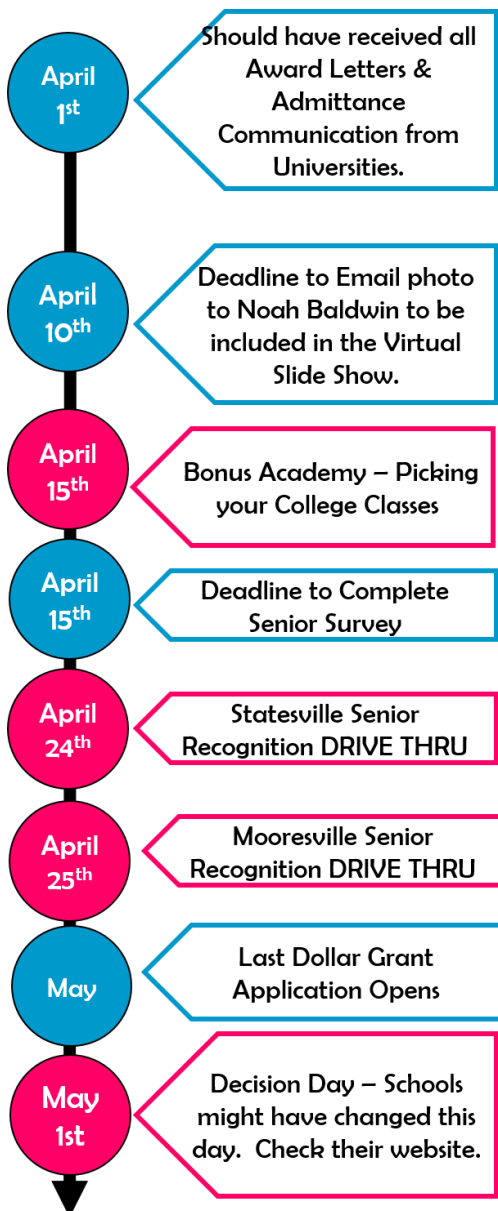

### Timelines for Success April



#### College Admissions:

- ✓ Stay focused and finish high school strong
- ✓ Check your colleges' admissions portals and email regularly
- ✓ You Should have heard from all Schools by April 1
- ✓ Review any new circumstances to Make a Decision
- ✓ Once you've decided, confirm your decision with the school of your choice, pay the deposit (if necessary), and inform the other schools you've decided not to attend
- ✓ Sign up for Freshman Orientation and make sure all deposits have been paid. Especially Housing Deposits to secure residence. (Lots of these types of things are a moving target for most schools. Stay connected!)

#### Financial Aid:

- ✓ FAFSA & Profile should have already been filed.
- ✓ Review your FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR); if your FAFSA was selected for verification, request a tax transcript from the IRS for your 2019 taxes and submit it along with any other required documents according to your schools' instructions
- ✓ Save a PDF version of your Student Aid Report and make sure your parents have a copy.
- ✓ Compare financial aid offers to help make your decision You should have received all Award Letters by April 1, 2020
- ✓ Contact the financial aid office at the university of choice with any questions.
- ✓ Apply for Last Dollar Grant on Crosby Scholars Portal – Open Beginning of May.
- ✓ (Review your high school's scholarship bulletin, online scholarship resources, and apply for scholarships)

#### Crosby Scholars:

- ✓ Complete the Senior Survey— See Link in Newsletter
- ✓ Meet with your Senior Advisor If you need additional help.
- ✓ Read the April edition of DestinationCollege2021
- ✓ Update your Crosby Student Portal with an email that will follow you to college. (Your HS email will be discontinued upon graduation.) Check your email and student portal at least weekly
